Entry Fee: CHF 800.00 per team

- sand and ballast water at disposal on launch site from Aug 31st
- invitation to Opening Ceremony for 4 persons;
- lunch on launch field at the day of take-off for 4 persons;
- snacks on launch field in the early evening before take-off for 4 persons;
- invitation to Welcome Back Party for 4 persons;
- invitation to Closing Ceremony/Award Banquet for 4 persons;
- FAI diploma / 2 sets of FAI medals (for Gold, Silver, Bronze)
- special rate reductions for hotel accommodation, Hotel Säntispark, CH-9030 Abtwil (official Hotel partner, Competition Centre, General Briefing, Opening Ceremony);

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations received on or before Saturday, June 30st 2022, will receive refund of 50% of the entry fee. No refunds will be issued on cancellations received after this date.

- declaration of number of teams (by e-mail, attachment 1 of the Official Invitation)
- nomination of entering teams (by e-mail, attachment 1 of the Official Invitation)
- music notes of their country's anthem, i.e. the score and complete sets for a brass band of 40 musicians (by Mail/Parcel Post)

By Teams before Thursday, March 31, 2022, 11pm UTC:

- confirmation of their authorisation by their NAC;
- completed entry forms (will be sent to teams after nomination by their NAC);
- confirmation of the paid entry fee (CHF 800.00);
- copies of following documents (** current original documents will be verified at Check-In):
 - FAI Sporting Licences (pilot and co-pilot)
 - o Pilot Licences (pilot and co-pilot)
 - Radio Licence (pilot and co-pilot)
 - Passport Pages (essentials and picture pages of pilot and co-pilot)
 - o ** Medical Statement if part of the requirements for the license (pilot and co-pilot)
 - ** Log book with last 2 pages/10 flights (pilot and co-pilot)
 - o ** Airworthiness Certificate of the balloon
 - ** Insurance Certificate for the balloon
- further documents for official programme and media communication:
 - o photographs of pilot, of co-pilot and of the balloon
 - short biography of pilot and co-pilot to be published in the program (e.g. regular occupation, ballooning activities since ... , gas balloon achievements, other achievements/ballooning activities,)

Insurance

Balloons must be insured to the standard specified in the Competition Rules, at least 3'000'000 XDR (approx. CHF 4'200'000) for third party liability during the Coupe Aéronautique Gordon Bennett. (Insurance can neither be purchased from nor be completed by the organizer).
